#### By Car

(from the A212)

Get on to the A212 (Coombe Road) , turn into Birdhurst Road and fork left into Birdhurst Rise and then left into Beech Copse. This is a dead end and the club and Car Park are at the end of the road.

(from Croham Road)

Get on to Croham Road, turn into Birdhurst Road (near South Croydon BR) and fork right into Birdhurst Rise and then right into Beech Copse. This is a dead end and the club and Car Park are at the end of the road.

East Croydon BR station is 15 mins walk and South Croydon BR Station is 5 mins walk.

#### By Tram

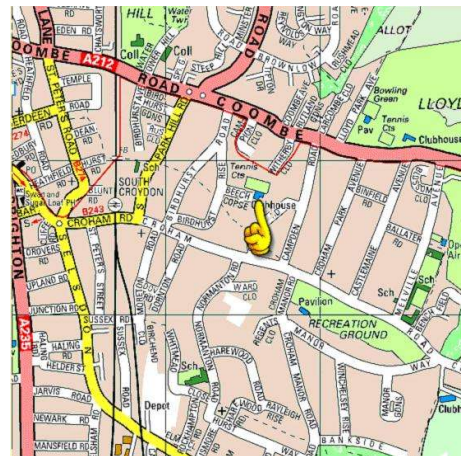
Lloyd Park station is 7 mins walk.
